

These are the Terms and Conditions for Booking all Entertainment & Equipment with Explosive Entertainment

1. Definitions

Explosive Entertainment and any employees (The Company EE)

Client: The person, organisation, company or other body which is hiring the services and/or goods as specified on the invoice.

Event date: The time and date of the event, confirmed by EE and noted on the invoice.

Booking Form: The invoice sent on behalf of the client and EE specifying details of the booking.

Day: A calendar day, unless specified otherwise.

2. Booking confirmation

A booking is not confirmed until the client pays any costs as outlined under 'Payments' in these terms and conditions, and receives confirmation of the booking from EE.

3. Payments

A non-refundable deposit of \$100 for Dj Services and \$250 for Photobooths of the booking cost is payable upon booking. The booking is not confirmed until the deposit is received by EE

The balance of the booking cost is payable 7 days before the client's event.

If the balance of the booking cost and the bond are not received more than 7 days before the event date, the booking will be cancelled and the client will forfeit the deposit.

If the client requests use of EE's services in excess of the time noted on the invoice, this will be billed at the addition times and price previously quoted.

4. Access, space & power requirements

The client shall ensure a safe and appropriate environment is provided for EE to operate its equipment and services.

The client must ensure:

- a space of 3m x 3m or more
- access to 240v power within 10m of equipment
- all doorways and access paths are at least 80cm wide
- if an outdoor event, an undercover area if any chance of poor weather

A survey of the event location may be required if EE is not satisfied that a suitable location will be provided.

The client is responsible for paying any charges imposed by the venue, or required to access the venue. These charges may include, but are not limited to, parking and electricity.

5. Changes & cancellations

Requests for changes of the event date must be made at least 30 days before the original event date. A date change is subject to availability and receipt of a new invoice.

All cancellations will result in the client forfeiting the deposit, however if EE is notified of cancellation more than 30 days before the event date, credit to the value of the deposit will be given to the client to use for any future booking made within 6 months of the date of cancellation.

Cancellations made within 30 days of the event date will result in the client forfeiting all payments made to EE, with the exception of the bond (For Photobooth) which will be returned to the client within 5 business days after the date of cancellation.

EE can cancel any booking at any time. If EE decides to cancel a booking, all payments made will be refunded to the Client.

6. Damage to equipment

In order to prevent damage to equipment, EE reserves the right to deny service to any person.

If circumstances arise where a threat or implied threat of harm, damage or violence to EE's staff or equipment, EE reserves the right to cease providing services. If the client is able to resolve the threatening situation within 20 minutes, EE will resume services. If the situation is unable to be resolved, EE will not resume providing service and the client will receive no refund of booking cost.

Any damage to EE's equipment during the client's event caused by the client, client's guests or any other person in attendance at the event whether invited or not, will result in the cost to repair/replace the equipment in question.

7. Images

The client gives permission for all photos taken during the event to be used on EE's website and other promotional Advertising.

8. Indemnification

EE will not be held responsible for any circumstances outside their control. This includes, but is not limited to, fire, riot, civil commotion, accidents, acts of nature and equipment failure. If such circumstances arise, all reasonable efforts will be made by EE to provide service or find a suitable replacement service.

The client agrees that in all circumstances, EE's liability is limited to an amount equal to the booking cost and not be liable for indirect or consequential damages.

9. Attendants

Attendants are to be provided with a supplier meal at all functions of 4 hours or more to the same standard as the guests of the function

10. T&C Agreement

The deposit received from the client will suffice that these terms and conditions have been read and adhered to.
